

Ceiling Cleaning is Green Friendly Environmentally & Economically

The cleaning of ceilings is green friendly, environmentally and economically. The removal of dull tiles fills a dumpster, the contents of which are then taken to a land fill. The tiles reside in the land fill for years while they decay. The replacement of the old tiles is costly. The purchase of sufficient tiles to fill a ceiling can be hundreds or thousands of dollars, depending on the size of a ceiling. This can be economically damaging.

Cleaning a ceiling with proper green friendly chemicals prolongs its life and improves its appearance. The use of green friendly chemicals allows an existing ceiling to remain in place longer with an improved appearance of 60-70% for acoustical tiles and up to 80% for vinyl. Additionally the sanitizing of the tiles reduces odor, eliminates the buildup of skin cells, dust, and other debris. The cost of cleaning is minor in comparison to replacement.

Ceiling cleaning is done after hours with minimal disruption to the work environment. A ceiling cleaning company should cover furniture and equipment or move it aside. In a kitchen environment mobile equipment may be moved around. A client will need to remove papers, food, and breakables. The next morning it may be necessary to vacuum or mop the floor and to reposition equipment.

When the ceiling is cleaned, light fixtures, vents should be included. Flush fluorescent lights can be cleaned on both sides of the lenses. As a result of the cleaning of the ceiling and the lights, an area will be brighter and more appealing to customers and staff.

If tiles are permanently stained or damaged, the cleaning company may be willing to quote replacement. Stained or damaged tiles will stand out more after the cleaning. Having them replaced during the cleaning creates a complete

professional look that will remain in place for years which will be green friendly, environmentally and economically.
